

VENDOR POLICY

Kansas City PBS actively seeks to identify and do business with companies owned by certified* diverse vendors. Encouraging a diverse vendor base and an inclusive vendor selection process enhances our mission to the community.

Kansas City PBS vendor diversity goals:

- Increase the participation of diverse vendors in contracting opportunities thereby increasing the likelihood of contract spend with these vendors while maintaining current standards of quality, competitive pricing and customer service.
- To the greatest extent possible, ensure at least one diverse vendor is included for consideration in all contracting opportunities.
- Ensure diverse vendors are treated fairly during the solicitation, award and administration of contracts.
- Encourage diverse vendors to become certified through the appropriate organizations.
- Use the Kansas City MWDBE* directory and various third party organizations to identify potential vendors.

Diverse vendors are defined as businesses owned by the following groups:

- Women
- Specific racial and ethnic groups
- Veterans
- People with disabilities
- Small or disadvantaged businesses
